We believe the ultimate purpose of faith-based education is to serve God and God's creation.


We believe all children can learn and that parents are the primary educators of their children.

We strive to educate the whole child by building a strong foundation of lifelong learning, critical thinking skills, technological competence and responsibility, and application of Catholic values across the curriculum.

St. John Bosco will align curriculum to new diocesan standards as needed. *Strategy*:

- Implement new diocesan standards
- Update curriculum to align with the new standards as needed, using a variety of funding sources
- Create curriculum maps in all subject areas
- Monitor English Language Arts Benchmark© curriculum series (K-6)
- Collaborate through vertical articulation and Professional Learning Communities (PLC)

Foster inclusion and awareness around multicultural education, as a means of taking a culturally responsive approach to our Catholic identity around the world.

Strategy:

- Create a school-wide World Culture Day
- Provide opportunities for students to share personal cultural experiences
- Continue to emphasize heritage events
- Implement a school Geography Bee

Continue to differentiate for all students in all subject areas, ensuring that each child is growing to their fullest potential, meeting each individual child at their learning level.

Strategy:

- All teachers will continue to provide after school instruction for remediation
- Utilizing title funding, grants and operational budget; administration will continue to offer professional development on best practices
- Continue to track (Acadience/DIBELS, MAP and IOWA) testing data
- Resource teachers will continue to assist in the classrooms with centers, testing, coaching students, and supporting teachers

Strategy:

Administration is committed to maintaining the highest standards starting from the enrollment process and throughout each child's time at our school.

Prioritize support for the enrollment and re-enrollment process to maintain efficiency and support SJB families. Strategy:

- Schedule a "new family meet and greet" each trimester
- Continue expansion of the Mentor Family Initiative
- Clearly communicate the enrollment process
- Maintain financial transparency
- Provide resources to maximize the use of STO, ESA, and scholarship opportunities

Maintain K-8 student-teacher ratio of 25:1 to ensure a quality Catholic education for all learners.

- Sustain operational budget

- Promote parish involvement for our future leaders

- Provide faith formation for adults
- Schedule the Religious to visit school/classrooms frequently

All stakeholders will embrace the idea of continuous improvement to create facilities that not only support academic excellence but also cultivate the heart of our mission in educating the whole child.

Create a five year facility plan to meet the needs of our growing community in a fiscally responsible manner.

Strategy:

- Develop a facility plan to include the following:
 - Update/Replace playground equipment
 - Update restrooms
 - Replace outdated HVAC units on a rolling schedule
 - Build additional classroom space
 - Renovate multi-purpose spaces
 - · Paint fencing, trim, and doors of school building
- Share plan with all stakeholders
- Implement facility plan
- Revisit facility plan annually
- Purchase updated resources with fundraising efforts
- Budget for 2 HVAC units to be replaced each year in operational budget
- Research and apply for grants
- · Create a capital campaign to fund the project
- Use endowment funds
