Next Nov. is accreditation. Given 4 goals: • Develop SLE Rubrics (laser cards, etc) – all done • Enhance the climate culture within facility and staff • To increase the student experiences and STEM - media lab and JH model. AV Club now 5th through 8th grade. (gathering photos of everything to show accreditation team). • Develop English, Language Arts Curriculum. We are switching from semesters to tri-semester • Purpose of accreditation is to hold school accountable. Goal is to get a six-year visit next time, not 2-year visit. • Teachers are driving force of this process. • Accreditation team will ask to meet with school board. • Survey going out in Feb. and the questions come from WCEA.
