Bylaws	Further revisions of the bylaws to clarify and correct confusion regarding individuals appointed mid-year following a vacancy and those taking the place of members who still had years left in their term. There was discussion and then agreement of the following principles: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Mid-year vacancies will be filled by the pastor appointing someone (in consultation with the Principal and Board President) to complete the year. If they choose to continue, then they will need to apply at the time of the call for applicants at the end of the academic year. 2. Vacancies that occur due to members not fulfilling their full 3-year term will be filled with the annual selection process. Members selected through this method will fill a 3-year term.
