

Mask Requirements:

Per the Maricopa County mandate, children 6 years of age and older are required to wear masks. This would include students in 1st through 8th grades. See schema below.

We ask that students bring an extra mask to school everyday. The extra mask should be kept in a sealed container/baggie stored in their backpack. The mask should have loops that hook comfortably around the child's ears (no bandanas or neck gaiters allowed). Students may wear a shield if they choose but will still need to wear a mask underneath to prevent the spread of vapor. [How to safely wear a mask](#)

Mask Schema

| Classroom | Mask On | At desk or table, physically distanced |
| Snack Time | Mask Off | Outside with class |
| Morning Recess | Mask Optional | Outside in designated area with class |
| Lunch | Mask Off | MPR, physically distanced at tables |
| Lunch Recess | Mask Optional | Outside in designated area with grade level |
| Mask Break | Mask Off | Individually outside, as needed |
| P.E. | Mask Optional | Outside and/or MPR, physically distanced |
| Mass | Mask On | Church or classroom, physically distanced |
| ESP | Mask On | At physically distanced grade level tables in MPR |

Approved Solid Colors:navy, gray, black, green, yellow, white, and uniform plaid are recommended. However, any solid color is acceptable.

Masks may be bought from any store or handmade. For your convenience you may also choose to purchase masks at the sjbstore.com.
